DECISION

The Slovak Accreditation Agency for Higher Education (hereinafter referred to as the “Agency”), pursuant to Section 4(2)(a), points 3 and 4 of Act No. 269/2018 Coll. on the Quality Assurance of Higher Education and on Amendments and Supplements to Act No. 343/2015 Coll. on Public Procurement and on Amendments and Supplements to Certain Acts, as amended (hereinafter referred to as the “Quality Assurance Act”),

concerning the participant in the proceedings:

Pavol Jozef Šafárik University in Košice

with its registered office at: Šrobárova 2, 041 80 Košice

(hereinafter referred to as the “participant in the proceedings”),

in proceedings initiated pursuant to Section 21(1)(a), point 3 of the Quality Assurance Act, upon the application of the participant in the proceedings for the accreditation of habilitation proceedings and inauguration proceedings in the field of habilitation proceedings and inauguration proceedings Anatomy, Histology and Embryology, assigned to the field of study General Medicine, based on Resolutions of the Executive Board of the Agency No. 1. VR-98/61/2026 and 2. VR-98/62/2026 of 9 July 2026, pursuant to Section 31(6) of the Quality Assurance Act in conjunction with the Standards for Habilitation Proceedings and Inauguration Proceedings of 17 October 2024,

has

decided as follows:

1. The Agency grants the participant in the proceedings (Faculty of Medicine) accreditation for habilitation proceedings in the field of habilitation proceedings and inauguration proceedings:

Anatomy, Histology and Embryology,

assigned to the field of study General Medicine.

By obtaining this accreditation, the participant in the proceedings is granted the right to conduct habilitation proceedings in the above-mentioned field of habilitation proceedings and inauguration proceedings.

2. The Agency grants the participant in the proceedings (Faculty of Medicine) accreditation for inauguration proceedings in the field of habilitation proceedings and inauguration proceedings:

Anatomy, Histology and Embryology,

assigned to the field of study General Medicine.

By obtaining this accreditation, the participant in the proceedings is granted the right to conduct inauguration proceedings in the above-mentioned field of habilitation proceedings and inauguration proceedings.

According to Section 21(8) of the Quality Assurance Act, the Agency shall state in its decision the reasons that led it to adopt the decision and the deficiencies identified. Reasons need not be provided if the Agency fully grants the participant's application.

Instructions on appeal:

Objections against this decision may be submitted to the Slovak Accreditation Agency for Higher Education within 15 working days from the date of its delivery.

This decision may be subject to judicial review after all ordinary remedies have been exhausted.
